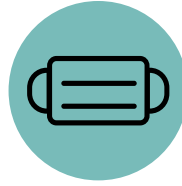


HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES



DAILY PROTOCOLS

Daily health and temperature screening is required for all attendees. Individuals who do not pass these screenings will require secondary evaluation by EMT to be considered for admission.



FACE MASKS ENCOURAGED

Masks are strongly recommended indoors in the State of Georgia. Attendees will be required to wear masks in meeting rooms and at education sessions.



SOCIAL GATHERINGS

SANITIZING STATIONS

Sanitizer will be available throughout the venue. Increased cleaning and disinfection will occur in high touchpoint areas and surfaces throughout the venue.

Anyone with pre-existing medical conditions, weak or compromised immune systems or signs of illness are encouraged to stay home.



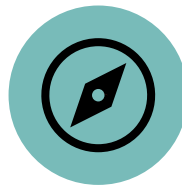
TRANSPARENT BARRIERS
