As we prepare for the October 24-25, 2020 event, taking place at the Cobb Galleria Centre in Atlanta, Georgia, we want to assure you that we are following all guidelines set forth by the CDC, WHO, as well as state and local officials. In an effort to host a safe and productive event, we will continue to monitor the developments around the COVID 19 pandemic and provide updates to this document and our policies which are subject to change.

We are actively working with the Cobb Galleria Centre to address the venue's health and safety guidelines and develop an onsite preparedness plan. Expect to experience elevated procedures for health checks, cleanliness, sanitation, and physical distancing, along with enhanced safety and socially responsible procedures.

Communications & Signage.

Hybrid Event.
 In an effort to meet the needs of all of our attendees, we will offer a "hybrid" event solution for the October show which includes a virtual market place prior to the show in addition to the in-person October event. More details to come.



Floor Plan Modifications.
 Adjustments have been made to the floor plan, gathering areas, and seating in sessions to accommodate physical distancing.
 Designated entrances and exits will also be used to control traffic flow.



Transparent Barriers (Sneeze Guards).
 Barriers will be used in high contact areas such as registration and gathering areas. In addition, each exhibiting company will be provided with a transparent barrier.




"No-touch" Temperature Screenings.
 At each point of entry, 'no-touch' temperature screenings will be conducted. Individuals displaying a temperature, defined by local, state or federal recommendations, will be removed and taken to a private area for a secondary temperature screening by EMT.



Face Masks.
 All attendees will be required to wear face masks, at all times. Each attendee will receive a disposable mask during badge pickup.



Sanitizing Stations & Enhanced Cleaning.
 Hand sanitizer dispensers will be deployed throughout venue and the show floor.
 Increased cleaning and disinfection will occur in high touchpoint areas and surfaces throughout the show and venue.
